- Either companies, before EETS setting up on the European territory, ETC service, payment or service card issuing companies
- Companies issuing, distributing or rendering an interoperable electronic toll collection service according to Directive 2004/52/EC only in competitive markets

In both cases companies listed above cannot

- Be operating toll systems nor be in Toll Charge role (according to the definition given in Decision 2009/750/EC)
- Nor can they be affiliates of Toll Chargers unless they have acceptance agreements for their services or equipment (cards, badges, payment services) in more than one European country

Membership acceptance is subject to a General Assembly decision based on the information given by the Company and its commitment to EETS compliance.

- (e) maintain a global risk management plan, which is audited at least every two years;
- (f) be of good repute.
